Thank you for your pre-registration as proctor at Univ of New Brunswick. You will receive email communication once a team selects you as their proctor.

Your involvement as proctor is extremely important. The primary goal is to make sure the students are having fun. Additional responsibility are outlined below: However, we recommend that you also ensure they are comfortable and getting adequate rest, and are eating, drinking and exercising during the 24 hour competition.

Proctor tasks include:

- Monitor the general flow of the activity
- Inform students when the competition begins, at the middle of it, when there are 6 hours left and when there is 1 hour left
- Ensure that no one external to the team members helps or assists the student participants in resolving the problems in any way

Please note: A change to this year's Proctor Guidelines no longer restricts the number of teams a proctor can proctor. However, we ask that you only accept the number of teams you feel you can successfully manage given the tasks outlined above.
